We used microscopes and chromatography to compare samples of hair, soil and ink as well as making comparisons of footprints and fingerprints. We are very excited for next week, to find out if we managed to catch the culprit.



#### Year 6

In Geography this week, we did some coding with conservation in mind. First we looked why the oceans are so important and then explored some of the issues that our oceans face. Plastic being the main one.

We then used laptops and iPads with the 'Scratch' website to create our game. We needed to use 'selection' and 'conditions' to help whales catch fish and avoid some hazards.
